TECHNICAL DETAILS

1. Condition for participation

R4

Category Gender Junior, U23 M, W, MIX (only for RX)

2. Team(s)

There is not a maximum number of teams that a WRF Nation can register for the event.

Participants obligations:

Each participant is required to be present throughout the whole duration of the event.

Each participant is obliged to take part also in all of the non-sport activities.

Each team undertakes to compete against all other participating teams.

Each participant undertakes to compete against all other participants.

The absence of any member of a participating team from any part of the entire sport programme, opening-, prize-giving- and closing ceremonies may result in the team being excluded from the results.

3. Competition venues

The competition will take place in following venues: Villeneuve (Downriver) - Ivrea (Slalom, RX)

4. Technical Rules

The competition will be run according to current WRF rules under the direction of the WRF Judges. The detailed rules can be downloaded here: www.worldraftingfederation.com/documents/rules

5. Doping

Dope testing (for use of banned substances) can take place during the competition according to current WRF Anti-Doping Rules.

If selected for testing a competitor may be accompanied by an adult.

If a competitor is following a course of medical treatment which includes the use of prohibited substances according to the WADA prohibited list 2017 https://www.wada-ama.org/sites/ default/files/resources/files/2016-09-29_- _wada_prohibited_list_2017_eng_final.pdf, he or she must obtain from his/her National Anti-Doping Agency (NADO) a TUE (Therapeutic Use Exemption) that complies with the requirements of the International Standard and must inform the organisers immediately upon arrival.





ADMINISTRATION

1. Registration

The entry registration form must be duly completed on behalf of the National Organization's President and send it to the Event's Organization (EVENTS@FEDERRAFTING.IT) as soon as possible but at the latest by 30th June 2018. The registration will be open from 1st June 2018.

2. Fees

NOTES

Dora Baltea originates by Mont Blanc, the highest mountain in the Alps and the highest in Europe.

As it crosses the Aosta Valley, the Dora Baltea flows through the city of Aosta, ancient roman city. After it enters Piedmont, it passes through the city of Ivrea through the artificial venue that hosted the World Cup in 2007, the 2008 Canoe World Championships, Canoe Slalom 2016 and 2017 World Cup.

The river has the most beautiful and technical rapids of Italy, through the marvelous Italian vineyards and the river gorges, the class level goes from III to V.
